Exemption from Entry Test

On entry test exemptions, some professionals may either directly go to stage - 4 or higher stage

Through Entry Test

Holders of any recognized post-graduate qualification i.e., M.Com, MBA, MA, M.Sc., etc
First class graduates (any discipline) / B.Com (2nd div.)
Holders of BE, MBBS, LLB, CSS, FPSC, PCS
Intermediate / FE-I&II / passed upto module D of MFC Scheme (ICAP)
Intermediate PIPFA with graduation
Interimmediate of ICSP or any other professional institute as approved by the ICMAP Council
Graduate serving abroad
Graduates seeking admission in distance learning (correspondence) programme

B.Com (3rd Division)
Graduate of other disciplines (2nd & 3rd Division)
An equivalent qualification approved by the National Council
A candidate who has appeared in the final examination of a bachelor degree and is waiting for the examination results, if such candidate passes the Entry Test, he / she will be granted a provisional admission. However, registration will be granted only when he / she passes the degree examination.
